**Rules for Plein Air Event**  
hosted by *Arts in Midway*  
**October 14, 2006**  
in historic Midway, Kentucky

1. Artists must register by 8:00 a.m. Saturday morning, October 14, 2006. Registration will be open Friday, October 13, 2006 at City Hall, 101 East Main Street, Midway, Kentucky between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. Parties may also register Saturday morning between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.
2. The Artists' canvas, paper, board, etc. must be stamped by an authorized agent of *Arts in Midway* at registration prior to any work being done. The stamp at registration must be visible on the back of each piece of art submitted at the conclusion of the event. Your finished artwork may be signed on the front.
3. Each work of art must be started and completed "en plein aire" at any time during the Plein Air painting period on October 14, 2006 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Completed pieces must be delivered to the registration table between 3:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. Artists must designate at that time whether they wish for their work to be sold at auction that evening and designate a starting bid (minimum reserve) amount, if any.
4. Each artist may submit up to two (2) finished pieces of work for the competition and auction.
5. Each artist will contribute 40% of the proceeds from their sales of artwork at auction to *Arts in Midway*. Artists will receive 60%. Artists are not required to sell their work.
6. A Best of Show award of \$500 will be awarded to a piece of artwork determined by a three (3) judge panel.
7. An Artist's Choice Award of \$200 will be presented. Registered Plein Air artists are encouraged to vote for the most outstanding painting, which is representative of the Plein Aire Style.
8. *Arts in Midway* assumes no responsibility for theft, damage or liability. The artist is responsible for insurance of his or her artwork. We will make our best effort to assure the security of the artwork once it is at the judging site.
